Academic & Other Skills

Students focus on academic and social skills with the goal of obtaining their high school credential.

High School Diploma

Students earn course credits and receive their high school diploma through Thornton Academy or Old Orchard Beach High School, depending on residency.

HiSET Preparation

Students prepare to pass the HiSET exam (high school equivalency degree). Students may take the HiSET once they have turned 18 years old and their high school class has graduated. There are some extenuating circumstances where students under 18 may begin testing.
